TOWN OF WATROUS BYLAW NO. 06-2001

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF WATROUS IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO REGULATE THE BURNING OF REFUSE WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWN OF WATROUS.

The Council of the Town of Watrous in the Province of Saskatchewan, under the authority of the Saskatchewan Clean Air Act, Section 18, hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. All terms and expressions used in this bylaw shall have the same respective meanings as in Section 2 and 8 of the Clean Air Act and Section 11 of the Clean Air Regulations.
- 2. No person shall cause or permit to be caused the open burning of rubbish, garden refuse, manure, animal carcasses, any material classified as a dangerous good, or any material which when burned, will generate black smoke or an offensive odor including insulation from electrical coring or equipment, asphalt roofing materials, hydrocarbons, plastics, rubber materials, creosoted wood, or any similar material in an open fire in a manner that causes air pollution within the boundaries of the Town of Watrous.
- Section 2 of the Bylaw does not apply to outdoor fireplaces or outdoor fires, used for recreational purposes, burning charcoal or cut, seasoned wood, when:
 - a) The fire is contained in a non-combustible receptacle constructed of cement, brick or sheet metal with a minimum 18 gauge thickness and covered with a heavy gauge metal screen with openings not exceeding 13 millimeters; and
 - b) The size of the fire box of any receptacle does not exceed .61 cubic meters; and
 - c) A responsible adult is supervising the fire; and
 - d) The open fire is not set in windy conditions conducive to creating a running fire or a nuisance to another person; and
 - e) The fire does not cause unreasonable interference with the use and enjoyment of another person's property.
- 4. Section 2 of this bylaw does not apply to a fire, authorized by the Fire Chief or designate, for the purpose of burning weeds, the prevention or control of fire or the training of persons for fire fighting, if the fire is specifically authorized or required pursuant to any act or bylaw.
- Any person who violates or fails to comply with any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offense and liable on summary conviction to the penalties set out in the general penalty bylaw of the Town of Watrous.
- This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon approval by Saskatchewan Environment and Resource Management.
