Compost/Tree Trimming Collection:

Only reasonable amounts of tree trimmings, **not tree removal**, will be picked up. Tree leaves may be bagged. All other compostable material (i.e. grass clippings) must **NOT** be bagged and should be piled on the ground at the edge of the lane. Bagged material, other than tree leaves, will not be picked up and it is the owner's responsibility to take it to the transfer station.

Any materials for pick up must be piled near the alley at the location that can be accessed by town equipment, and away from fences and buildings. **We require tree trimmings to be piled separately from compost material as we are no longer permitted to burn compost material.**

Unsightly Properties:

Please remember it is the responsibility of all property owners to keep their property clean and tidy at all times. This includes cutting overgrown vegetation, removing junk vehicles, correct storage of outdoor materials, maintaining fences in a safe and reasonable state of repair and removing old appliances.

Trailers/Vehicles parked on streets/lanes/town property:

Residents are reminded that the Town of Watrous restricts the time allowed to park vehicles, including RV's, trailers and boats, on any public street or right of way to a maximum of 48 continuous hours. Please remove any infrequently used vehicles from the public right of ways to allow for adequate street maintenance and to help ensure that visibility isn't reduced for pedestrians, cyclists, motor vehicle operators. Please remember that boats, trailers, etc. cannot be parked on Town property or in back lanes, please ensure these are parked on your own property.

Business Licenses:

Business Licenses are required by any trade, occupation or business not assessed for commercial property taxes.

Dogs and Cats:

In accordance with Bylaw 21-2013 any dog/cat caught running at large will be impounded and issued a fine to the owner. Please be a responsible pet owner and keep your dog/cat confined to the limits of your yard, unless on a leash and under your control. As well, it is your responsibility to clean up any defecation on public or private property.

Residents are limited to a maximum of 3 dogs and cats per household and are required to license them with our office. If you have not yet purchased your 2017 pet license please do so immediately.

Recreation News:

Swimming Pool registration will be held in the Heritage Room on Monday, May 29th at 7:00 PM. Please remember to line up around the building not across 5th Avenue.
