## Important Dates

- Registration deadline is October 12<sup>th</sup> after which a late registration fee of \$25 is applied.
- Lessons Thurs, Nov. 1<sup>st</sup> through Thurs, Dec. 11<sup>th</sup>, 2018, and Christmas Skate on Tuesday, Dec. 11<sup>th</sup>
- Lessons Tues, Jan. 8<sup>th</sup>, 2018 to Tues, Feb. 14<sup>th</sup>, 2019, and Year-end Skate on Thursday, Feb. 15<sup>th</sup>
- NO lessons on January 24, January 29<sup>th</sup>

## Lessons

- Skaters are registered for either Tuesday-only lessons, Thursday-only lessons or Tuesday-and-Thursday lessons
- Age 3 skaters will have a half-hour lesson (3:45-4:15pm).
- Age 4+ skaters will have one-hour lesson (3:45-4:45pm) and will be offered a short warm-up at the coach’s discretion.
- Lesson will include a ‘warm-up’ free skate & stretch, basic skill instruction and fun activities.
- Participants gain experience on skates and an appreciation for skating
- Includes free public skating and one-hour Christmas and Year-end skates

## For Your Information

- Parents are responsible for tying their child’s skates.
- Skaters must wear helmets for their own safety. They will not be allowed on the ice without an *effective* helmet. Please ensure that the helmet fits tightly (does not wiggle side-to-side or front-to-back) before the children step on the ice.
- Registrants are not allowed on the ice until the coach is present.
- Volunteers are available to assist beginners. Parents with skates are welcome on the ice, but not mandatory. ALL parents/helpers on the ice *must wear skates*.
- No food is allowed on the ice including gum and hard candy.

- Skaters wishing to withdraw from LTS mid-season will be refunded the remaining full months.
