

ARENA GUIDELINES

Entering the Watrous Centennial Arena

- Players, coaches and spectators must use front entrance
- Masks are mandatory for players/coaches/spectators/public skating/shinny
- Please use the QR-Code for contact tracing. Public skating/shinny – sign in book if you are unable to use QR-Code
- Can only enter the WCA Center **15 minutes prior to practice**
- Use hand sanitizer at front entrance
- All patrons must maintain a minimum physical distance of 2 meters (6ft) at all times

Players / Managers / Coaches

- **All** user groups are encouraged to come fully dressed – dressing rooms will be available
- Teams must designate 1 or more people to ensure compliance with:
 - monitoring, screening and collecting names / phone numbers of players, coaches & spectators. This information must be retained for 30 days for Public Health's contact tracing
 - arriving / departing within the 15-minute allotted time frame
 - dressing rooms are free of garbage, water bottles...etc
- Players need to bring full, labelled, water bottles. The water bottle filling station will be available. No sharing water bottles
- Spectators must stay in the WCA along the railing on the East and West walls while watching but are encouraged to stay in your vehicle or stay home if possible. User group must sanitize where patron stand or sit with cleaner located in the furnace room.
- No spitting, high fives and or hand shakes

Dressing Rooms

- Rooms will only be available to players 15 minutes before their session
- Players must leave rooms 15 minutes after their session
- No showers allowed
- Players must wait in dressing rooms or in designated spots until coaches call them to the ice

Exiting the WCA

- All players, coaches and spectators must use the exit the East doors if assigned to Dressing Room 1 and 2 or the North doors if assigned to Dressing Room 3, 4 or 5

Cleaning and disinfection

- Dressing rooms will be sanitized between each team by the user group – Sanitizer is located in each dressing room or in the furnace room
- All high touch surfaces will be disinfected throughout the day

Public Skating

- All patrons must sanitize their hands upon arrival and sign in with your name and phone number – Use QR-code
- All patrons must make payment in the drop box
- All skaters can use the skate tying chairs provided along the glass – please sanitize after use. Sanitizer is located in the furnace room
- All patrons must leave out the East doors
