Burials are strictly prohibited without the issuance of a Town License and either a Burial Permit or a cremation certificate.

Cremation Burial

- Burial of cremains without a certificate of cremation is prohibited. A copy of the cremation certificate must be provided to the Town Office before a license will be issued. License and Burial fees apply.
- Scattering of ashes in the Watrous Cemetery is strictly prohibited.

Columbarium:

- Maximum 2 urns per niche
- Urns must be stainless steel, bronze, copper, stone, glass or fiberglass
- Urns made of degradable materials must be placed in a poly urn vault
- Bronze Plaques are provided by the Town of Watrous and included in the price of the niche.

Monuments

- All grave markers/headstones within the Watrous Cemetery shall have concrete or granite foundations installed flush with ground level. The foundation must not exceed forty-two inches (42”) in width, twenty-four inches (24”) in length and must have a minimum depth of three inches (3”). Grave markers/headstones are required to be sized to maintain a minimum peripheral margin of three inches (3”) of the base size.
- Section 4 – Plots 34 to 43 and all of Section 8
These sections are designated flat or pillow marker areas. Grave Markers/Headstones must not exceed thirty-six inches (36”) in length, eighteen inches (18”) in depth and must not exceed fifteen inches (15”) in height. Foundations for markers are required and are to be sized to provide a minimum peripheral margin of three inches (3”) larger than marker. (See attached)

General Rules

- All graves require a fiberglass vault over the casket.
- One traditional burial per plot with two (2) additional cremations allowed after a burial.
- A maximum of two (2) cremations are permitted per plot.
- Only one (1) headstone permitted per plot.
- Headstone must be installed at the top of grave.
- Permission from the Town of Watrous is required before undertaking any type of construction, alteration, installation or repairs within the cemetery. This includes installing, repairing or altering any monuments, memorials or grave markers.
- The Town of Watrous has the authority to remove all floral designs and flowers left on plots or headstones; as well as removal of existing trees, shrubs, plants or herbage of any kind as soon as, in the judgment of the town, they become unsightly, dangerous or detrimental to the cemetery.
- **Prohibited:** surface grave covers, fences, curbing or landscaping materials of any sort, planting of trees, shrubs, flowers or greenery (other than grass), ornaments and solar lights of any kind.
- Permission from the Town of Watrous is required before undertaking any type of construction, alteration, installation or repairs within the cemetery. This includes installing, repairing or altering any monuments, memorials or grave markers.

Legion Plots

- Legion plots only - 30 plots in Section 7 (being plots 10 to 20, 55 to 65 and 100 to 110)
- New Legion Plots – 27 plots in Section 7 (being plots 1 to 9, 46 to 54 and 91 to 99)

Other

The Town of Watrous may consider purchasing back an unused plot(s), for the original purchase price, with the amount being applied towards the purchase of a columbarium niche.
